Looking at the list of queries below, which of the subject numbers do they match? For example, *rock AND bomb* matches 3, 8, 9, and 11.

- a) rock OR paper OR scissors

- b) rock AND (paper OR scissors)

- c) (rock AND paper) OR (scissors AND bomb)

- d) (rock OR paper) AND (scissors OR bomb)

- e) rock AND (paper OR (scissors AND bomb))

- f) ((rock AND paper) OR scissors) AND bomb
